Ways to use your grill safely and according to local codes Must follow the rules of the National Fuel Gas Code, ANSI Z223.1/NFPA 54, Natural Gas and Propane Installation Code, CSA B149.1, or Propane Storage and Handling Code, B149.2, or the Standard for Recreational Vehicles, ANSI A 119.2/NFPA 1192, and CSA Z240 RV Series, Recreational Vehicle Code, as needed. Be careful with chemicals like lead and benzene when handling this product. Please read this manual carefully before using your grill and keep it handy for future reference if you are assembling this unit for someone else. The following rules should be followed: - Do not use gasoline or flammable liquids near the appliance. - Store an LP cylinder not connected for use away from the appliance. 1. Begin by distributing all components thoroughly. 2. Ensure that all hardware is tightened directly as indicated in each step, taking care not to over-tighten which could cause damage or strip threads. 3. Complete each stage according to the presented sequence for optimal results. To assemble and use this product, you will need: • (1) Leak detection solution (directions on making the solution are included in the "Operating Instructions" section of this manual). • (1) A precision-filled LP gas grill tank with an Acme Type 1 external threaded valve connection (standard size) (not included). Page 26 W Always carefully open the grill lid slowly as heat and steam trapped within can cause severe burns. W Never attempt to disconnect the gas regulator while the grill is in use, or you may face serious consequences. W Place your grill on a hard, non-flammable surface for safe operation. Avoid using asphalt or blacktop surfaces. W Keep gas hoses away from hot surfaces and dripping grease to prevent accidents. W Electrical cords should never be near a hot grill to avoid electrical hazards. W After storage, check the grill for leaks, burner obstructions, and hose wear to ensure safety. W Failure to open the lid while igniting or not waiting 5 minutes after attempted ignition may result in an explosive flame-up. W Never operate the grill without its heat plates installed for your protection. W Use a meat thermometer to ensure food is cooked to a safe temperature. W Wear protective gloves when assembling this product, and avoid forcing parts together as it can cause injury or damage. 1. Be aware of LP gas characteristics before use: * LP gas is explosive, heavier than air, and settles in low areas. * It has no natural odor but contains an added smell like rotten cabbage for safety. * Contact with LP gas can cause skin freeze burns. 2. Safety guidelines for apartment dwellers using a LP gas grill: * Check local requirements and fire codes. * Use outside on the ground floor, at least 10 feet away from structures. * Do not use on or under balconies. 3. LP gas cylinder specifications: * Must be marked "propane" and meet U.S. D.O.T. or Canadian safety standards. * Must have a vapor withdrawal system, OPD, compatible connection device, and cylinder collar. 4. Warranty information: * Limited warranty of 1 year for parts from date of purchase. * Covers defects in material and workmanship. * Requires proof of purchase and pre-paid return shipping. * Excludes damages due to accidents, misuse, or neglect. RA disclaims all express warranties for products purchased from unauthorized sellers, including merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose. The grill has been checked for leaks at all factory connections, but you should re-check them as described in the Operating Instructions section, as shipping can loosen connections. Even if your unit was assembled by someone else, check for leaks too. Do not operate the grill if a gas leak is present, as this can cause a fire or explosion. Follow all instructions in the Checking for Leaks section before operating, and always perform a leak test before lighting the grill and each time the cylinder is connected for use. Additionally, do not smoke while conducting a leak test, and avoid using matches, lighters, or flames to check for leaks. Be cautious when testing for leaks, as strong odors, colds, sinus congestion, etc., may prevent you from detecting propane. Never store or use gasoline or other flammable liquids or vapors within 25 feet of the appliance, and keep the grill area clear and free from combustible materials. The minimum clearance from sides and back of the unit to combustible construction is 36 inches. Do not use this appliance under any type of overhang or roof. **Important Safety Information** Before using this BBQ grill, please read and follow these instructions carefully to ensure your safety and prevent potential harm. Failure to comply may result in injury or property damage. **General Guidelines** - Store gasoline or flammable liquids/vapors away from this appliance. - Never allow cooking oil/grease to exceed 350°F (176.5°C) while using the grill. - Keep extra cooking oil at a safe distance from appliances. **Additional Safety Precautions** * Handle propane cylinders with care and follow proper installation instructions. * Ensure the grill is installed, assembled, and maintained correctly. * Never operate the grill unattended. * Follow all operating instructions and take necessary precautions to avoid accidents. **Installation and Operation Instructions** Refer to pages 5-8 for detailed instructions on installing a gas cylinder, setting up the gas regulator, and using the grill. **Maintenance and Care** Follow the cleaning and care guidelines on page 10 to ensure the grill remains in good condition. **Specifications and Warranty Information** For more information on specifications, warranty details, and refund policies, please refer to pages 11-12. **Troubleshooting and Contact Us** Refer to page 12 for troubleshooting tips or contact us at [insert contact information] for assistance.
