Key Stuff/ Packing List:

Essentials: Bible / Notebook or journal / Pen or pencil / Sleeping bag & pillow / Active clothes for warm and cool weather / Jeans & sweatshirt for the evening / Tennis shoes / Clothes you can get dirty and play in (rec clothes) / Toiletries / Sandals / Sunscreen & bug spray / Modest bathing suit (*Girls -1 piece (no cheeky / thong bottoms or a large dark t-shirt over 2 piece); Guys - no speedos & shirts must be worn when not swimming*) / Towels (bath & pool) / Trash bags for dirty clothes / Water bottle / Flashlight

*****Prescribed Medications, Vitamins & Supplements:** These will be collected and dispensed by the camp health center. We consider any vitamin, supplement, or over-the-counter therapy that is taken to treat a condition or maintain health to be a "medication". We are not able to give a medication that we cannot identify and dose from the original container. Sending medication in anything other than the original container may result in the camper not receiving it.

Special Dress Essentials

*****Middle School** - White t-shirt for dye wars and dark clothing for the night game.

*****High School**- Fancy Friday: Guys usually wear a nice button up shirt and Girls usually wear a casual sun dress.

*****Rec Colors** - Not mandatory, but awesome way for your rec team to be more spirited!

Middle school - Kelly Green & Purple

High school - Salmon & Sea Blue

We do not know which team your child will be placed on, so it is wise to send both colors. Ideas for spirit wear are: bandanas, headbands or arm bands, face/ body paint, tutus, wigs, glasses, morph suits, etc.

Dress Code

*****Girls** – NO 2 piece bathing suits can be worn without a large dark t-shirt. NO midriiffs. NO spaghetti strap or tube top. NO visible bra straps. NO cheeky / short shorts. These are Hume Lake rules. Please respect them!

*****Guys** – NO low-ride pants. Shirts must be on when not swimming. NO underwear showing above waistline.

Spending Money - Bring money to cover your lunch on the way up to Hume and for lunch on the ride home. All additional spending money is up to your own discretion. \$10-15 per day spending money is recommended by Hume Lake (snacks, camp picture, boats, etc). The students LOVE Hume swag...don't forget to include money for extra t-shirts, sweatshirts, water bottles, stickers, etc.

Leave These Things at Home: Vapes, mods, juuls, joints or other narcotics, alcohol, firearms, shoulder-mounted rocket-propelled grenades, bad or bullying attitudes, any form of stinkeye and NO pranking materials!

Hume requires all campers to complete a swim test if they want to do ANY water activities (pool, lake, or pond). These will take place on Sunday and Monday.

Medical Screening will happen on the morning of our departure. Hume does not allow sick kids to come up to camp.
